Phase 1 Breaking ground and moving in!



Summer 2021: Local contractors and volunteers prepared the new campus for its first academic year. With severe labor shortages, community love for Red Fox delivered.

- log cabin: up to fire code & adapted for our specials classes: music, art, and Spanish.
- 2nd floor: created office space, a library, a teacher's room, & sick room.
- campus site prepared for temporary classrooms – The Lodge! This required major excavation, tree removal and a parking lot.
- onsite well conversion to a public well system: Expert engineers helped with this difficult process.

Next, we will convert the existing pole barn into a fully functioning community space. It will be insulated, heated and we will install a bathroom and kitchenette. We will also create an adaptable stage platform for our many school recitals, open mics and plays.
